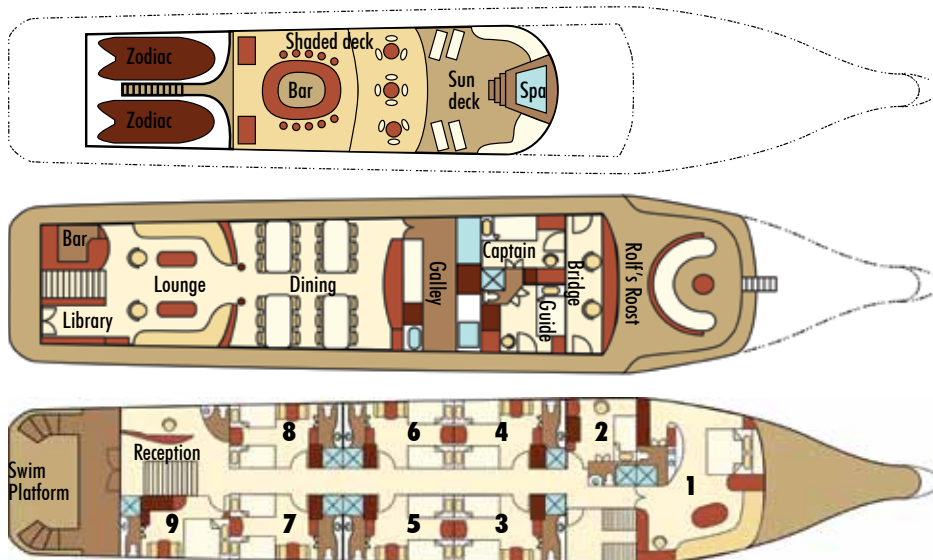

Integrity

The *Integrity* sails the Galápagos Islands on routes designed to maximize time ashore at the most interesting visitor sites. She sails on two alternating routes created to share not only the most visited sites but also least-visited gems.

The Western Route focuses on the younger islands of Isabela, Fernandina and Santiago, whereas the Eastern Route focuses on the older islands of Española, San Cristóbal and Genovesa. Each has its unique delights.

Galápagos adventures on both routes start with at least one overnight on the Island of Santa Cruz to explore the highlands and visit the Charles Darwin Research Station before boarding the *Integrity*. This way we can spend one entire extra day in the outlying islands.
